Integrated Pest Management Plan (IPM)

Pest control policy for the District was put in place January 1998 and revised May 11, 2000. All documents pertaining to IPM for the District are located in the Director of Facilities office and can be viewed during normal school hours or setting an appointment with Brian L. Smith at ext. 1115.

**Inspections and Applications 1st Wednesday of every month
after regular school hours**

Current pest control for the District is as follows:

1. Using ant, rodent, and roach baits in areas where pests are known to seek harborage routinely or where infestation is present. Baits are out of sight of students.
2. Using traps and monitoring devices to help identify pest problems or when they are first introduced into the structure.
3. Monthly inspection audits to help monitor and correct pest problems.
4. Using growth regulators to control insects if infestation is found.
5. Spot crack and crevice treatments with low odor and low impact insecticides only applied under low pressure and only if insect infestation is present. During application No children or staff present in school, athletic complex, or areas of play. All applications made in compliance with product labeling.
6. When a pest problem constitutes an immediate threat to the health of students, staff, or may cause a serious disruption to school activities, the District may want an immediate treatment to eliminate problem, Examples are bees, hornets. If so students and staff will be cleared from area prior to application being made in accordance with product labeling.
7. All applications made by Trained Service Technician or Commercial License applicator.
8. Documentation will be filled on all applications containing the following information: Start and stop time of application, date, brand name of pesticide, amounts used, product EPA registration number, areas treated and by whom.
9. Copies of Earlywine's liability and vehicle insurance on file.
10. Copies of certificate of insurance, licenses, and MSDS will be provided as requested.
